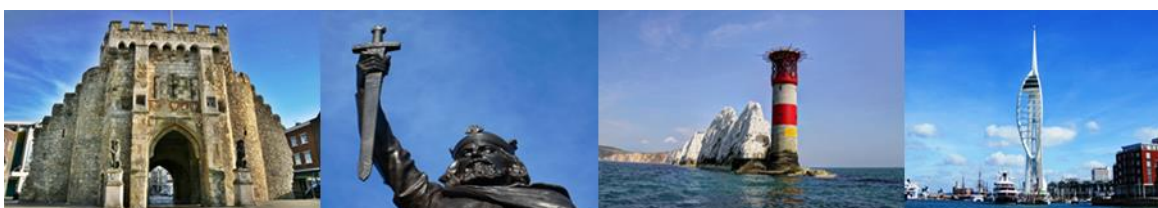

This Training Resources Directory is not an exhaustive document, and should be added to and amended with future knowledge and experience. It reflects training that is available throughout the 4 SHIP areas; noting that some organisations provide training solely for their own staff, and some local authorities/CCG's currently provide training only to their commissioned services.

The training resources listed are for guidance only and do not represent a recommendation to use them. Some training providers will make a charge for their courses.

The subject headings are listed in alphabetical order and are aligned with the findings of a training survey which was undertaken to find out what training is being given to staff who support the TCP cohort of individuals in the SHIP area. 63 organisations responded to the survey, with only 12 (19%) advising that they felt the training currently given to their staff was adequate. The survey therefore gave clear guidance in identifying training needs and gaps.

If you already have an account with e-LfH, then you can enrol on to the Disability Matters programme by logging in to the e-LfH Hub, selecting My Account > Enrolment and selecting the Disability Matters programmes. You will then be able to access the programmes immediately in the My e-Learning section.
